

WHOLE SCHOOL FOOD POLICY

Policy Statement

The Governing Body recognises its responsibilities for setting a strategic framework for a whole school food policy and for monitoring its implementation.

The Governing Body, with the support of the parents, staff and children of the school, will make every endeavour to ensure that healthy food and drink is provided, reflecting nutrition and healthy eating messages in the curriculum and taking account of individual needs, whether cultural, ethical, or medical.

Whole School Food Policy

The Governing Body of Greatstone Primary School and Nursery will:

- continue to follow the recommended nutritional standards for in-house school lunches and ensure that the food provided is of a high quality and promotes health.
- ensure that the Whole School Food Policy interacts with relevant school policies, in particular with the Curriculum Policies.
- continue to ensure that the choices provided address cultural, ethical and medical needs.
- Recommend appropriate training for the school's Catering Staff to ensure up to date nutritional standards and recommendations are followed.
- seek parents' agreement on a lunchbox policy in line with the Whole School Food Policy.
- endeavour to ensure that lunchbox contents are in line with the Whole School Food Policy.
- continue to appoint a Governor with special responsibilities for the Whole School Food Policy.
