Starfish Class.






Hello, I am Miss Turner.

When you arrive into Starfish Class you will self-register here.






You will have your own peg to hang your coat and bag on. Your wellies will go underneath your peg.

Where do I go to the toilet?

If you are toilet trained, you can use the toilet at any time.

These are in our classroom, just here.





If you are toilet training, you can use one of our potties.
These can also be found in our toilet area.
Ask an adult to help you.

If you wear a nappy, an adult will change your nappy on the nappy mat, which is also in the toilet area.



Will I be able to eat and drink in Starfish Class?

You can have a drink from your own water bottle at any time.





Our snack bar is open throughout the day so you can decide when you would like to eat your snack.

If you are staying for lunch, you will eat your packed lunch at our dinner tables.



How long will I be at Nursery for?

You may be here for the morning or the afternoon, or maybe you will be here all day. Ask your mummy or daddy.

You get to vote for which story you would like, will your favourite be the winner?






what are the rules?

What will I need at Nursery...

- " A change bag containing a complete change clothes including socks and underwear. (More than one set if potty/toilet training).
- " If required, nappies/pull-ups and wipes.
- " Wellies -that can be left at Nursery all year.
- " A wet suit—for water play and wet weather outdoor activities.
- " Warm coat and winter hat
- " Suncream and Sun hat (as per our suncream policy) during the warmer weather.
- " A named drinks bottle—containing water (juice is only permitted with lunch)
- "If you are staying for a lunch session and having a packed lunch you will need a lunch box or bag. This must be clearly named as we have several identical bags and due to food allergies must ensure that each child receives the correct lunch.
