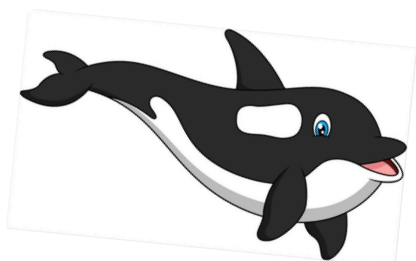
Key Dates this term:
