English

Reading: 'Wonder'

We are enjoying a story about a boy who is going to school for the very first time and the worries he has due to 'being different'. We learned more about VIPERS to analyse the story. Ask me what these mean!

Writing: 'Coming to England' and 'Gregory Cool'

This term, we have written diary entries as a child from Trinidad who moved to England in the Windrush Generation and stories as a narrator, learning the difference between first and third person.

<u>GPS</u>: Fronted adverbials, expanded noun phrases, inverted commas, possessive apostrophes.

Maths

Place Value

We built on our knowledge from Term 1, understanding and investigating the value of different digits. We have compared and ordered numbers with up to 4 digits.

Addition and Subtraction

We have used number lines to support us in using mental addition and subtraction. We have also looked at formal written methods to add and subtract.

Science

Living Things and their Habitats

We became experts in the use of classification keys to help group, identify and name a variety of living things. We learnt about the 7 characteristics of a living thing (MRS GREN). Then we made classification keys to identify local invertebrates. Finally, we made observational drawings and a large-scale group drawing of an insect.

Humanities

We have learnt all about islands of the Caribbean, understanding the difference between human and physical characteristics.

Along with this, we have explored traditions, food and culture, enjoying Jamaican music, exotic fruit and then turning our experiences into an eye-catching information leaflet.
